

REQUEST FOR SLOGAN

Candidates filing a petition may request to have a slogan appear with their name on the ballot.

The number of words permitted in a candidate’s slogan depends on the type of candidate.

Partisan candidates participating in a Primary Election may request a slogan up to SIX words and must be in accord with N.J.S.A. 19:23-17. No such designation shall include or refer to the name of any person or incorporated association of this state unless the written consent of such person or incorporated association has been filed with the petition.

Independent candidates participating in the General Election and any **school board candidates** may request a slogan up to THREE words in accord with N.J.S.A. 19:13-4. Such designation shall not contain the designation name, derivative, or any part thereof as a noun or an adjective of any political party entitled to participate in the primary election.
