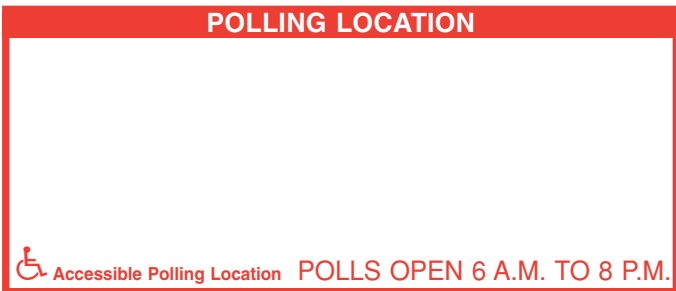

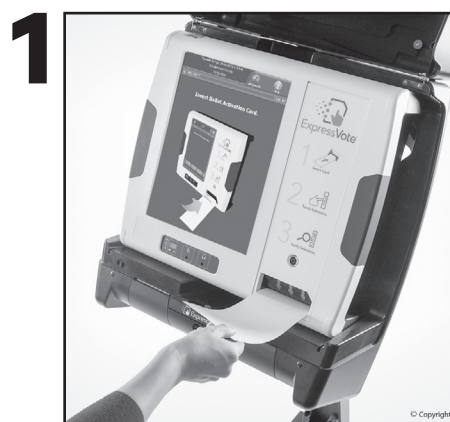

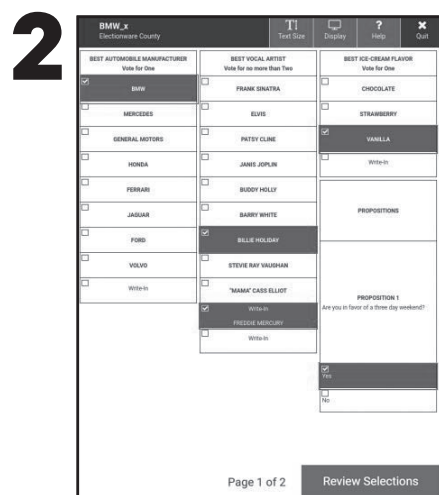

HOW TO USE TOUCH SCREEN VOTING



**1 Activate Your Ballot**

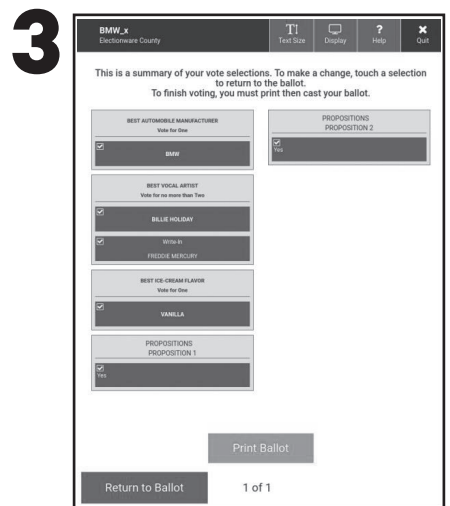
To begin your voting session, take the *Ballot Activation Card* given to you by the poll worker and insert the card into the ExpressVote's Activation Card Slot.

**Vote Your Ballot**

On the voting screens, touch the candidate of your choice. To vote for someone not on the ballot, touch **Write-in** and use the on-screen keyboard to enter your write-in name. When done, touch **Accept**.



**3 Reviewing Your Vote Selections & Casting a Ballot**

Once all selections have been made, a summary of your voted selections will appear. Review your selections; if needed, touch the contest for which you wish to make changes. Make the desired changes and return to the summary review screen.

When done verifying selections, touch **Print Ballot** and then **Print** to print your voted selections onto the ballot activation card. Take time to review the information on the card to make sure your selections were recorded accurately. Place your voted card into the privacy sleeve provided by election staff and proceed to the tabulation scanner.

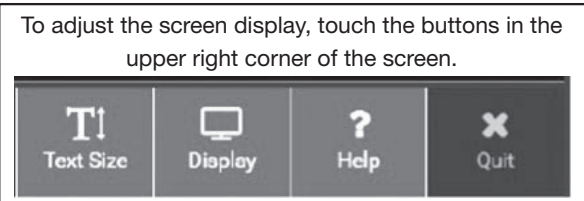

**Insert Your Voted Ballot Card into the Tabulation Scanner**

Your ballot is not counted until it is inserted into the tabulation scanner. Remove your ballot from its privacy sleeve and insert the card into the tabulation scanner. The card is deposited into a secure ballot box and is retained by the Board of Elections.

A "Thank You for Voting" screen confirms your ballot has been counted.



To adjust the screen display, touch the buttons in the upper right corner of the screen.

**ATTENTION VOTER!**

**For the 2022 Primary Election, you have TWO OPTIONS for in-person voting on a voting machine:**

**1**

**Vote at your regular polling place on ELECTION DAY, June 7th from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m.**

**2**

**Vote at one of THREE designated EARLY VOTING centers from Friday, June 3rd through Saturday, June 4th from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. Sunday, June 5th from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.**

**TOP 5 THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT IN-PERSON EARLY VOTING**

**1. WHAT IS IN-PERSON EARLY VOTING?**

*This new option enables all registered voters who did not already request a mail-in ballot to cast a ballot in person, using a voting machine, during a three-day period prior to Election Day.*

**2. WHERE CAN I ACCESS IN-PERSON EARLY VOTING?**

*No matter where you live in the county, you can vote your specific ballot at any one of the three Early Voting polling locations (listed below).*

**3. WHEN CAN I ACCESS IN-PERSON EARLY VOTING?**

*In-person early voting locations will be open Friday through Sunday, June 3rd, June 4th, & June 5th. Hours will be Friday-Saturday, 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. and Sunday, 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.*

**4. WHAT IF I ALWAYS VOTE BY MAIL, BUT NOW WANT TO VOTE EARLY, IN-PERSON, INSTEAD?**

*If you already requested to vote by mail in the 2022 Primary Election, you are not eligible to vote in person on a voting machine for the June 7th election. If you'd prefer to vote early in person in future elections, contact your County Clerk to Opt Off the vote-by-mail registry. To opt off the Vote-By-Mail registry, call the County Clerk's Office at 973-579-0900, ext. 1507.*

**5. CAN I STILL CHOOSE FROM OTHER VOTING OPTIONS?**

*Yes. You may select instead to (1) Apply for a vote-by-mail ballot with your County Clerk's office or (2) Vote in Person at your polling place from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Election Day, June 7.*
