DID YOU ALREADY RECEIVE A VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT?

If you already requested and received a vote-by-mail ballot, don't delay in returning your voted ballot. Ballots must be received by the County Board of Elections by close of polls on Election Day, or within 6 days of Election Day if received by mail provided that the ballot envelope bears a postmark no later than Nov. 7, 2023.
