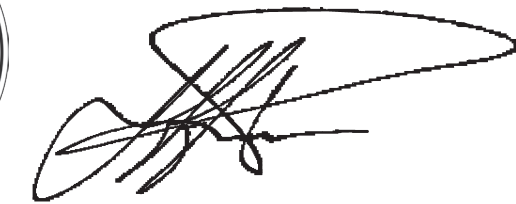

Ballots must be received by the County Board of Elections by close of polls on Election Day, or within 6 days of Election Day if received by mail provided that the ballot envelope bears a postmark no later than Nov. 5, 2024.
