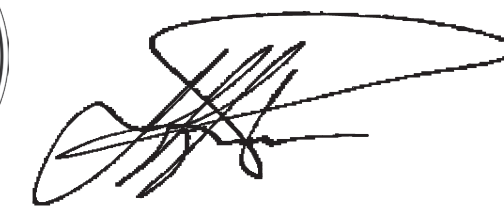

No Nomination Made DEMOCRATIC	Jayson Citrich	The Board of Education of the Borough of Hopatcong in the County of Sussex, New Jersey is authorized: (a) to provide for renovations, alterations and improvements at Hopatcong High School, Hopatcong Middle School, Durban Avenue Elementary School and Tulsa Trail Elementary School, including acquisition and installation of equipment, site work and related work and costs; (b) to appropriate \$9,897,300 for such purposes and (c) to issue bonds of the school district for such purposes in the principal amount of \$9,897,300.
No Nomination Made DEMOCRATIC	Jennifer Polowchena	The final eligible costs of the projects approved by the Commissioner of Education are \$9,897,300 (with \$5,942,600 allocated to Hopatcong High School, \$699,300 allocated to Hopatcong Middle School, \$459,400 allocated to Durban Avenue Elementary School and \$2,796,000 allocated to Tulsa Trail Elementary School). The projects include \$0 for elements in addition to the facilities efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g). The State debt service aid percentage will equal 40% of the annual debt service due with respect to the final eligible costs of the projects. The Board of Education is authorized to transfer funds among the projects approved at this election.
